General Report Comments: I arrived at the property and shouted at the gate. The mainhouse is quite a distance from the gate. No response to my calls. I could see 2 dogs from the gate. 1 seems to be tied up and the other behind a gate. I then wrote out a NTC and as I was about to stick it to the gate, I saw a lady emerge from the main house. I then called out and she came to the gate. I explained to her my reason for visit and if I may enter to examine the living conditions of the dogs. The lady made herself known as Jeannette and stated that she is the owner of the property and the dogs. 1 dog was on a 4m long light static chain. It has a kennel and water available. The other dog is in the courtyard with a stoep and a passage. The dog on the court yard is an escape artist. The dog on the static chain was between poles and this restricted her moving space. I moved the kennel and chain and the dog immediately had more space and movement. I gave the owner the NTC which states that confining an animal unnecessarily which does not afford the animal adequate space and movement is an offence in terms of the APA. The owner then stated that if the dogs were sterilised, she would not have to confine them. I arranged to pick up the dogs in next week. I will follow up on the steri's
