Margaret then left. The person that lives in the main house on the property then came out. She said that Margaret does come home in the evenings and Margaret does feed them. She said that the only problem that she has is that the dogs sometimes escape the property and that she must sometime put them back. Mcnolan from Law enforcement advised her that if she wants to she can phone them when the dogs are in the road and they will collect the animals as strays. I am going to close this case until further notice as there are no welfare concerns. It is more of a neighbourly nuisance related complaint. I will also advise the complainant as such and refer her to Mcnolan Plaatjies to follow the correct channel to see the bylaw complaint through. NFA
