Upon closer inspection I could see that the dog Boesman is very thin and her living space is dirty and inadequate. I asked Michael if Boesman has food and when last was the dog dewormed. I told Michael that the symptoms that Boesman is showing is signs of tickbite fever. Boesmans living conditions are also inadequate. After some talk with Michael I advised him to surrender the dog to the Spca because Michael does not have money for a vet. Refer to admission D3890. No other animals on the property.
