He requested to know the details of the complainant, as he feels harassed due to Law Enforcement being at his property and now us as well. I advised him that I can not divulge the complainant's details, and he requested the court order stating such. I advised that I will email him with the details (see attached email).

Regarding the sheering of the sheep, he sheers the sheep 1x year. The person he uses was due to come in the beginning of October but could not. He is waiting for the person to advise him when they will come, it will either be at the end of Oct or beginning of Nov. He disputed the fact of any urgency regarding the sheering of sheep and stated that sheep use their wool to regulate their temperature. I advised that I will not argue with him and will consult a few livestock veterinarians regarding the necessity of sheering sheep and revert back to him.

He advised that sheep is next to his house and that they are visible from Oostewal street.

I returned to the property at around 13h00 and saw the sheep. They are kept in a large camp, with alot of trees and grazing. The sheep are in good condition. They are evidently due to be sheered.

I will call Dr Kotze from Korhaan Veterinary Practice, and Dr Trichard from Blue Cross next week to discuss this.
