I took a dust road into the farm but I didn't see houses or anyone on the farm. I ended up in Koringberg and I asked a few people but they didn't know who the owner of the cattle is. I proceeded to Bovlei farm and I met Mr William De Waal who happens to be the owner of the farm. He is the owner of the cattle on the farm where there is the Bottlefontain farm sign post. There is trees available for the cattle to use as shade and I also observed fresh drinking water point and a small dam on this farm. I then proceeded to Bossiesvlei and Bovlei where he is farming with Hereford cattle breed. I drove deep into the farm away from the N7 road and I observed a lot of trees and water points. The body condition of all the cattle that I observed is fair and acceptable. I couldn't find Sandfontain farm and SopaBona farm. I will go back to see if I can find these two farms. On all the farms that I visited I didn't see any sheep .
