General Report Comments: Upon arrival I was met and granted access to the property by a female who identified herself as Lynn Bosch, the wife of the owner.

She called the dogs and I firstly observed the dog of concern. The dog was in poor condition, was just laying in one spot and when I called the dog, the dog had difficulty standing up and moving around. The dog had a sever skin condition, suspected advances sarcoptic mange, and the dog also had several cancerous growths. Lynn called the owner, on my request and I advised the owner that the dog is suffering in my opinion and that they must rather surrender the dog. The owner agreed, and I admitted the dog.

The other dog, named Bullet, likely has early mange stages or a severe skin condion due to other medical reasons. The owner did not want to surrender the dog and I then proceeded to issue the owner with a warning insteucting the owner to take the dog to a veterinarian within the following 7 days for assesement and possible treatment. I also provided the owner with the contact and address details of Village Vet in Atlantis. Accordingly to Lynn they will ensure to take the dog, as they love their dog.

I did not observe any APA concerns regarding the other dog.

The dogs roam freely inside the property, has a large bath with potbale water, receive supermarket no name food which they mix with house food. The dogs were taken to the last mobile clininc in the area for deworming and has 2x large kennels and a carport to protect them against the weather elements.

Follow up to done regarding issued for veterinary treatment for Bullet.

The warning expires on a Friday, however I will conduct the follow up on the following Monday as I will be at the Saleyard next week.
