General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by Ian Olivier, the owner.

He accompanied me onto the property to physically inspect the animals.

The section where the dogs roam is a U -shape yard, that extends to the back of the house.

The area was clean and the animals are in a exceptional good condition. They are all sterilised, except the young kitten, she will go in at 6 months. All the animals are microchipped and has their vaccinations up to date. The dogs are fed Montego Classic, and the cats are fed Montego for cats.

The property was clean, there is sufficient shade and a large kennel that is placed in the shade as well. There was water and food for the dogs available during my inspection.

The 1x dog, Black/White named Lexi had an old wound on her head and nose, this has healed and is now only a scab. The 2 dogs played a bit rough and it ended with Lexi sustaining a wound, this happended apparently more than 2 months ago. The owner is struggling for the scab to fall off and the wound to heal 100% as all the ointment he received from the vet is licked or pawed off. I advised he obtain Teramycin wound spray from the Agrimark, as the dogs wont be able to lick or paw it off and the spray infuse into the skin.

There was no APA contraventions observed during the time of my inspection , and I am confident in closing this case as no further intervention is required.
