General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met outside the property by Granwill, he is the care taker of the animals.

He immediatly advised me that he knows who complained and that there is a big dispute between them. He also advised that there is a court case pending against the SPCA for tresspassing , he was reffering to a time when Stephanie Fortein was employed and apparently entered the property with a neighbor without the owners presence or consent. Not sure what happend with this, but I advised him that we are in the present now and shared the nature of complaint.

He took me to the back yard where I saw the 2 dogs free roaming. There is no grass, it is only cement and gravel.

He advised that they pick the feaces up once a week and today (Thursdays) is the day they would pick up. I did observe feaces layong around but it was not that much to state the animals are living in it. They only use the gravel section to defecate, the cemented area is clean and thisnis where the dogs sheltered area is as well as their food and water. The dogs also sleep inside the house.

Granwill advised that he had an outfall with his neighbor recently and it is no surprise that we are here now. He asked "why now of the sudden there is an issue with the feaces, I have not changed my routine of picking up once a week".

The German Shephard definitely has a very bad breeding bloodline as she had a very low back and possible hip displacement, this is however not affecting the dog at all. The dog is walking, running, and jumping without discomfortant. However, I did advise the owner to take his dog annually for a vet check to prevent the condition worsening.

As I wanted to take pictures, Granwill stopped me and said that he is not granting me permission to take photos of his property.

No contraventions in terms of the APA was observed.
