General Report Comments: PROACTIVE

Upon arrival at the property, I saw a Pitbull, F, Brown, Adult dog kept on a short static chain, approximately 2m long in front of the house. The dog had a suitable collar fitted. The dog has 180 degree radius movement on the chain. The dog has access to water and is in a fair condition with the ribcage barely visible.

The property has no fence, hence the dog is chained. The dog has a suitable, selfmade wooden kennel which provides adequate shelter against the elements.

I advised the owner that the chain is rather short that that they will have see what will work best on the property, as a running chain might cause the dog to be to close to the pathway and road. Stephanie advised that her husband will be home tonight and that they will then plan and see what will work best. I also advised that the dustbin be moved, as this is reducing the dog's current space and that the unnecessary rubble laying around the dustbin must be picked up. Stephanie had the children picking up rubble while we were talking.

I advised they either install a runner, if the space allows more movement, or to place the dog on a 360 degree radius light chain, with an extension of at least 2m to the current chain, or to extend the current chain by at least 2m. Any of these three options will grant the dog more roaming space.

I also issued a warning stating such.
