General Report Comments: PROACTIVE

Upon arrival, I observed 1x dog chained to a pole anchor. The chain is approximately 1.5m long and the dog had a chain fitted as a collar. The dog has a large wooden kennel, however the front opening is open completely and does not provide the dog with sufficient protection against the elements . The dog appears to be in good condition with no current veterinary or health concerns observed.

The property is not well fenced, hence the dog is chained. Clint advised that the dog was previously on a runner, but the wire did not last. He showed me the pins in the ground, they are about 7m apart.

I advised Clint that he must use a thick cable and make sure the cable is tight, and make use of swivels on both ends. I also advised to use hosepipe and run the chain through for a collar, and to modify the kennel to have half of the front section closed.

This was all also noted in the issued warning.
