General Report Comments: Upon arrival, no one appeared to be home as there was no response to my presence.

I observed:
4x domestic geese (1x male, 3x female)
1x Pitbull x, female, cream

The geese were free roaming inside, has a large drum full of water to drink from. The dog is tethered next to a large wooden kennel, which provides adequate protection against the weather. I dont understand why the dog is still tethered, as the property now has a gate and I dont see how the dog will escape the property.

The tethered rope is approximately 6m long, and although the dog can roam sufficiently, I still think the dog can roam freely. The dog has a makeshift collar on, rope running through a thin hosepipe.

I will come back to the property to speak with the owner and find out what is going on here and see how we can change the dog's environment.
