General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner, Mike.

Mike accompanied me to the back of the property where I observed 2x dogs on runners.

**Dog 1:**

Lab x, female, adult, "Thea" kept on a running chain. The runner is approximately 7 meters long with an attaching 2m light chain with an attaching swivel and material collar. The dog had a large wooden kennel and dustbin available which provides adequate protection against the weather elements.

Inside the wooden kennel, on the left, behind the dustbin, is a pallet that is placed on the floor on which Thea can lie if she does not want to lie in the dustbin. The living area is clean, she has water and is in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.

**Dog 2:**

Pitbull, female, adult, "Chloe" kept on a rope runner. Which is approximately 5m long with an attaching 4m light chain with an attaching swivel and strong body harness. The dog has a large self made wooden kennel which provides adequate protection against the weather elements. The dog had water, a clean living l, in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.

The owner had this dog on his other property, with his wife, but they divorced now and only moved the dog to this property over the weekend.

The owner complied with the warnings issued. I will close this case for now, as there are currently no contraventions in terms of the APA
