General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner's wife.

I went to the area where the dog is kept and was rather disappointed when I saw the dog is still kept on the short chain and that the enclosure has not been fixed. I asked the owner's wife why nothing has been done regarding the enclosure, and she could not answer me. I indicated to her that all the material is laying inside the enclosure and that I don't understand as to why nothing had been done in the past 14 days, and that I gave them plenty time to fix the enclosure, as per the agreement made with her husband. She did not answer me, and unfortunately the husband was at work.

The dog was observed to be on a short chain, approximately 3m long with a material band as a collar.

The dog has evidently gained weight, as the rib cage, hip bones and spine were barely visible, which I am satisfied with.

I issued a 2nd warning:

1. The enclosure must be fixed and the dog free roaming inside the enclosure within the following 7 days.
