The shelter of the dog is not adequate,because it's a roof sheet that was put up against the wall that serves as shelter,if it rains the dog can still get wet because the shelter does not cover her from the rain. The female pitbull is also a bit underweight, but I could see that she had puppies recently. There were no puppies observed. There were no people at home. I issued warning W5097 to provide the dog with adequate shelter,to put her on a runner and to provide her with adequate food on a daily basis. Will follow up.
