General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner's girlfriend, Meagan, as the owner was at work.

I was accompanied to the back of the property, where I observed 2x dogs confined in self built enclosures.

Dog 1:
"TEQUILA"
(Bullterrier, Male, Adult, Brindle/White)
Enclosure is approximately 3m x 2m, soil floor with an old carpent in the corner for the dog to lay on, however the dog has claimed the water bowls tyre to lay in. The enclosure does not provide adequate space or protection against the weather elements. There was also 2-3 day old feaces laying in the corner (this was picked up immediately).

Dog 2:
"BRANDY"
(Pitbull, Male, 8months, White/Black)
Enclosure has 2 sections. The first section is approximately 3m x 1.5m with and extention at the back which is his sheltered area 1m x 1.5m), providingadequateprotectionagainsttheweatherelements. The dog had drinking water. There was also 2-3 day old feaces laying inside the front section (this was picked up immediately).The dog appeared to be slightly underweight and Meagon could not confirm when the dog was last dewormed.

The dogs are kept in enclosures as they are extremely aggressive and have bitten 2 people in the past already. The dogs were apparently first on short chains, then moved to runners (I saw the runner material), however the dogs kept breaking the runners or broke loose, and other dogs kept coming to the property trying to fight with them. They then decided to build enclosures for the dogs as this will keep the dogs and everyone else safe, since the property does not have a fence in front.

I advised Meagan that a few things must change and she seemed compliant and will relay all to her boyfriend when he is home later the evening.

I issued a warning:

1. TEQUILA

- * must have water at all times
- * must have access to adequate shelter, a kennel must be placed inside his enclosure - 7 Days granted
- * his enclosure must be enlarged by a minimum of 2.5m on both sides - 14 days granted

2. BRANDY

- * If the dog has not been dewormed within the past 3 months, deworm the dog - 7 days granted
- * his enclosure must be enlarged by a minimum of 2.5m on each side - 14 days granted
