General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I went from entrance 1, 2, 3, 4 and found the car parked farr away, under a tree by entrance 5. Not sure if the care was moved after being parked at entrance 1, as per the complainant's provided information.

The car is a red, Opel Monza with registration number : CFG34417.

I saw a Min Pin dog laying in the back of the car. The dog was very relaxed and did not pant excessively. Both the front windows of the car was left about 5cm open.

Security approach me and I shared the concerns with them and they advised that someone has already reported the matter to them and that they are currently looking on the cameras if they can spot in which shop the people currently area. The security gaurd advised me that the owners is an elderly couple.

I waited at the car, till the owners arrived. The measured temperature outside was 16 degrees and remained this temperature. The total waiting time was about 40 min.

The elderly lady explained that her husband normally sits with the dog in the car when they go to the shops, but that she fell badly last night and asked her husband to rather accompany her in the shops today as she will have difficulty walking. She also advised that the ships were very busy today amd that it took much longer that they anticipated. The lady was remorseful and apologized same.

I issued a warning:

In future to at all times ensure the animal is not left unattended in a car.

She understood and signed the warning.

The dog was monitored the entire time and did not show signs of distress, to an extend where I would have felt the animal require veterinary assessment.
