General Report Comments: Upon arrival, no one appeared to be home as there was no response to my presence.

I observed 2x Collies kept on the right side of the house. The dogs appeared to be in good condition, but I could not see if they have water, shelter.

I called the security company (MSS), as I saw a board of them on the wall. The controller advised me that it is probably an old board of previous tenants, as they don't have any one residing at this address with them.

I saw the dogs have collars with ID tags and I managed to obtain the contact number. I called the owner, Jacques, and shared the nature of the complaint with him. Jacques advised that they went away for the weekend and asked a close friend, Elaine, who resides close by to look after the dogs for the weekend and arrangements were made with her to come to the property 2x day. Jacques advised that he will call Elaine now and ask her to come and meet me at the property.

Within 10 minutes of my call with Jacques, Elaine arrived at the property. She opened the house and took me to where the dogs are kept. The dog has a large veranda which is closed and 2x large kennels which provides adequate protection against the weather elements. I saw empty food bowls, and Elaine advised that she fed them already this morning as she was there around 7am. I saw a large water bowl with clean and fresh water inside. Elaine also gave the dogs hooves to chew on. Elaine advised that the owners will be home later this afternoon.

The dogs appeared to be in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.

The dogs are not abandoned, and I think the complainant is more bothered with the noise they are currently making.

No APA contraventions observed, case can be closed.
