General Report Comments: I was met by Austin Stringer who gave me access to the property . I observed 1x brown terrier x female loose on the property. The dog appeared to be in acceptable condition. Austin then took me to the dog that was injured. I saw 1x brindle female pitbull on +-1.5meter chain provided with a collar. Water and shelter are available. The female pitbull called Suzie has open bite wounds on her body and her face is swollen,she is also underweight, body score 1/5. I asked Austin what happened and he told me that Suzie broke loose and was roaming the streets when 2x pitbull type of dogs attacked her. I asked Austin why Suzie is so underweight and he told me that they have been feeding her but she does not seem to put on weight. I told Austin that the dogs should be fed adequate dog food because pap,rice and potato peels is not sufficient enough for dogs. I also told Austin that Suzie might have tickbite fever, that's why she is not gaining any weight. I issued warning W5571 to provide the dogs with adequate food on a daily basis,to provide Suzie with veterinary care and to also install a runner because the chain is to short. Will follow up within 24 hours.
