We started with our inspection and we went to the quarantine site where they keep the sick dogs and we inspected the dog that was sick and he is getting better than our first visit and the kennel was clean and aslo the water was clean and he was wagging his tail.

We moved to kennel A14 and they have fixed the gate and the dog can't get his head in that open space also his kennel was clean and the water was also clean and drinkable.

All the feaces next to kennel C11 was removed and the drainage was also clean and they cleaned the feaces as soon as the dogs are pooing in the kennels as we instructed the previous inspection. The dog at C11 was removed from that kennel because the kennel is always wet and it makes the dog wet also.

All the water bowl was scrubbed as instructed from the previous inspection and they are clean and water is drinkable.

The dip bath was aslo cleaned and scrubbed while we were there they were preparing to dip the dogs.

The pallet was removed from the cage because of the sharp objects in it.

The owner of the company has complied and I am confident in closing the case as there are no further contraventions in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71of 1962 no further action required.
