General Report Comments: I received a call from SBM Law Enforcement Officer Mentoer stating that they received a call from the owner residing at 43 SWAELTJIE stating his dog was stabbed this afternoon. According to Officer Mentoer this does not fall within their mandate and the call is for SPCA. I asked him if he knows the condition of the dog, but he did not. I asked if he has the contact details of the owner, but he did not. Based on the little information provided it was unclear as to the severity of the matter, and I treated the matter as an emergency.

I arrived at the property and was met by a man named Tyson, and his sister. He advised that his dog was roaming freely in their property this afternoon, and 2 young men was walking in the street with their pitbull. The 2 dogs then begun fighting and the one man gave the other man a knife and he stabbed the dog. The 2 men then ran off.

The owner of the injured dog took his dog to Longacres Veterinary Clinic and the dog was treated accordingly. The owner advised that he would like to open a case of animal cruelty. I informed him that I will guide him with regards to the process to follow, and assist him where needed. I advised that I wont open the case as I will be a 3rd party in the matter, and since they observed everything and have eyewitnesses it will be better. I advised him to ask all the eyewitnesses to make statements at SAPS asap and also to ask the assessing veterinarian to provide him with a veterinary report.

The sister advised that she knows where the accused resides, but does not know the exact address and will have to show me the property. I made arrangements with her to go to the property tomorrow afternoon.

The dog is currently not suffering, as the dog did receive adequate veterinary treatment.
