General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I saw 1x pig free roaming. I went and walked through the enclosures. I saw the first lot of enclosures are still in a dilapidated condition and no animals were observed inside. I went to the one where I previously saw pig and saw 3x pigs inside. The pigs are fully grown, adult pigs, and they were laying together. The enclosure is large enough to provide them with sufficient roaming space. The enclosure is fairly clean with no excessive faeces inside. The enclosure is well constructed and provides adequate protection against the weather elements as it has a solid roof structure.

The pigs were quiet the entire time I was by them, no squeeling and vocalization was heard. They were laying comfortably and just looked at me. In my experience this is an indication that their basic needs are met, as if they were hungry or thirsty they would jump up, approach me and stand at the areas they normally receive food from and they would also be vocal.

The pigs appeared to be in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.

Some of the enclosures with no animals inside has their gates left open, which ensures that the free roaming pig(or pigs, not sure if there are maby more as I only saw the 1) has access to adequate shelter at all times as well. The free roaming pig was also calm and was laying in a muddy area when I walked towards the enclosures. This pig was aware of my presence but did not rush to me indicating his basic needs are med. When I approached the pig, he stood up and walked away from me.

It appears that here is still only 1x owner, and that the other have not returned.
