The owner came out and introduced herself and told us that the dog is tied because her property is not fenced and she is scared that the dog will get hit by a car and the dog chases the children. The dog has shelter with acceptable body condition. On closer inspection we saw that the dog's water bowl is dirty. We educated and advised regarding clean water bowl and Mrs Albertus cleaned the water bowl immediately. We issued a warning for the dog to be put on a runner chain within 6 days.
