General Report Comments: On my arrival in Abbotsdale, I went to house no 50 Skool street, there I was welcomed by Mrs Maurita Johnson, I introduced myself and explained my visit to her property, she then allowed me to conduct the animals welfare inspection:

1) I then observed a brown male adult boerbol dog breed with a short tail named Hitler , of which it was on a static chain of about +-6 meters long not to the collar. A steel pole was not adequately deep into the ground of which chances were there that the dog chain might tangle around the pole. Hitler appeared physically looking good in condition with no veterinary problems or health concerns.
2) Secondly, I observed a black+white male Bull terrier Cross breed of +-6 years of age named Rex, of which Rex was on a static chain of +-8 meters long to the collar(soft green water pipe), and the steel pole used attached to the pole was not adequately deep enough into the ground as the dogs chain might tangle around the pole.
Rex appeared physically not looking good in condition(was swollen under the jaw towards the right face side, and his left eye had discharges), the eye drop small bottle medication was available.

Shelter was available for both dogs separately, water was available, and living environment was cleaned.

Mrs Maurita said there a lady (Mrs Adri LA Meyer) will come to take Rex to the vet.

I then issued Mrs Maurita with a notice to comply to:

-polrovide the animal (Rax) with adequate veterinary treatment within 24 hours.....,

-put the animal/s on a *running chain " within 3 days.....,refer attached notice to comply no I5830.
