When I asked Mrs Kalonda the reason for this she said they are keeping the dog there because the dog tends to jump the fence when loose in the yard. I persuaded her to sign over the dog to the Sandton SPCA but she refused saying that the dog belongs to her husband whom was still out of country. The dog was given water in the kennel, I just couldn't see the condition in the kennel as it was dark. I issued her with a written warning for all these concerns to be rectified within 5 days.
