The vehicle was a silver, Nissan Hardbody, 2-Cab van. No sign of the owner during my arrival and throughout the inspection of the scene. After my inspection, I managed to seize the dog and left a Seizure Notice for the owner to contact me. The dog appeared to be seriously sick and I was unable to stand on his own. Food was provided in a suitable bowl but a container assumed to be for water was knocked down. The dog was laying on wet boxes caused by the spilled water, urine and vomit. The dog was admitted to the Sandton SPCA Clinic and primary care was provided. To wait to hear from the owner.
