Comments:	The project was still taking place when I found them at their usual place of fumigation. I met the pest control supervisor, Mr Arthur Jacobs from Flick pest control at their fumigation rendezvous and multipurpose community centre called San Kopano in Alexandra. The routine was still upheld and my techniques were still in use. On that morning about 171 rodents were captured and fumigated from all sectional wards(9). I monitored the fumigation accounting for every one of them. The rodents were still fumed for a minimum of 3 minutes per group and carefully moved into the disposal bag per body by a brief exam to confirm the end of life of the rodents. I had an opportunity to brief everyone on that day and gave advice on a few techniques to conduct their baiting (trapping). When I enquired about the clean-up campaigns, I was told they only take place rarely or when job creation campaigns are being introduced to the locals as they used to take place on Mondays but not anymore. The project has grown to bigger heights so much so that workers are being awarded in their respective performance categories in a way of retaining and encouraging good workmanship. I asked for an invite should there be any collaborative awareness campaigns in the community taking place. Routine inspections are to be carried out monthly
