General Report Comments: On arrival at the property, the owner's mother opened the gate for me to enter. There were over 20 chickens, a Leopard tortoise that she owned and 2 stray rabbits. The chickens were on the property to be brought up by her as woman as she could not rely on men to take care of them on a farm in Vereeniging, according to her. She had no permit to keep the tortoise but advised her to apply for one as she refused to surrender it. I told her that she's keeping an amount exceeding the approved number of chickens on a dwelling house in terms of the by-laws. Regarding the matter of noisy roosters, Mrs Mokakiso said that three of them were here a while ago but she slaughtered 2 of them because neighbours were complaining and some officials gave her a Notice regarding the noise . There was only a cockerel which she claimed hasn't started crowing yet. I told her to either surrender the chickens to remain with up to 10 on the property or make other arrangements to do so. I told her to clean up their coop at least every 2 day and construct proper brooding/nesting room together with perching posts (even suggested an off-cut tree log with branches). I wanted to capture the rabbits but she refused to let me saying she doesn't want any trouble with the neighbours. I wrote her a Warning to address the issues above and will be coming back in 3 days to check some of those concerns. To follow up on the 24/02/2023
