General Report Comments: On arrival at the property, the children from the house attended to me at the gate but said the cannot be able to let me into the property without their parents' consent. From the main gate I could see a male, adult, brown-choc Pitbull tied to a rope onto a steel that was sticking out of a wall. There was a wooden kennel as shelter, an HTH granular chlorine bucket and a dog bowl but wasn't able to see if there was potable water. I spoke to one of the owner's daughters named Natasha who did not want to give me or phone her parents at first. She contacted her father who I spoke to over the phone and he did not want me to enter the house to inspect the living conditions of the dogs. They told me that they were tying up the dog because there were construction workers on the property doing renovations. I wanted to view the condition and prevent any potential unnecessary suffering of the dogs. I left them a written warning to phone me within 24 hours to make an appointment to meet as he refused to tell me his availability. To follow up in 24 hours
