There were raw tomatoes on the floor supposedly fed to the dogs(4 adults). I asked the owner, Mr Mubetey why is he not cleaning but he only told me that he cleans the place and yet it didn't appear so. He said that the dogs will be sent to a new place in Hammaskraal where they will have a bigger place. The adult bitch had newborn puppies(6) in the enclosure while the males were still fighting for dominance. One male dog was hiding up a dustbin and was struggling to get to any place within the enclosure without being attacked by the alpha male. The dogs welfare wellbeing was becoming seriously compromised. I issued a written Warning for him to him once again even though I could clearly see that nothing will change . To follow up with a warrant of seizure.
