General Report Comments: Upon entry to the park, I met Mr Tankiso Mahlaba who showed me the dogs' holding cages. The dogs were returned after I instructed for the removal on the 10th of February 2023. 4 dogs were on duty during my inspection. The Imvusa Security Company claimed they have obtained a PAPA license but only presented the first page of the license and no second one that details the validity of the license. No Dog Handling certificates were presented to me in relation to the dogs and the handlers. Dogs on duty namely, "Sammy", "Rex", "Lilly Rot" and "Lilly" appeared to be in sufficiently conditioned physically and alert in posture. Potable water and adequate shelter were provided for the dogs. There were maintenance issues on the cages holding "Lilly" and "Sammy". "Lilly's" cage had a loose iron sheet and was sagging out of place. "Sammy's" cage found appearing to askew for being placed on uneven ground leaving gaps and holes exposed. There was poop waste in dog food bags allegedly waiting to be collected gathered in front of the holding cages. I issued a written warning to Imvusa Security Services to fix the issues addressed to them within 5 days. To follow up in 5 days
