General Report Comments: When we got to the premises, one of the workers gave me access to the poultry enclosure. The owner was not present during my inspection. There were 32 chickens, about 7 rabbits and a pigeon. The enclosure was dirty with food scraps (bread and bakeries) and pieces of boxes used to carry the food scraps. The chickens were provided with automatic water drinkers and concentrated milled pellets of Alzu general feed. The general feed was not palatable for most chickens, especially the younger ones. This impacted their weight and acquiring essential nutrients because the pellets' size was too big for them to swallow comfortably. the place where the chickens were kept was unhygienic and had not been cleaned for some time. A written warning was issued to the owner to keep the place tidy and clean at least every 48 hours. The pigoen was found injured and surrendered to us. Ad. No.
