General Report Comments: We stopped at this premises after seeing a signboard outside . A gentleman named Samson gave us access to the property. The owner, Mrs Tiny Tomic sells chickens, goats and sheep to the local public. The place has been running for over 13 years. The livestock was kept under substandard facilities and conditions. Goats and sheep were using a cargo container with a single-window as shelter and night enclosure. We discovered 2 goat nannies with limping legs. An adult red-headed & white nanny had loss of hair, a dull coat isolating herself by spending more time resting while the red nanny had a limping leg (on both nannies). The red one was actively feeding with the rest of the herd. She showed us all sorts of medication she had available although some had already expired. Food and water were provided in bathtubs and half-cut barrels with leftover food (apples and other fruits) that invited flies and bees. The running pen was messy with foreign objects around. The loading ramp was also getting dilapidated due to low or no maintenance. Some of the beams that secure the loading lairage were broken and out of place. The ramp had an uneven floor surface as bricks fell deep into the foundation. The ramp appeared to have been built by inexperienced bricklayers.

There were 6 other farm/country chickens (road-runners) and pigeons(caged) kept in a shed-sized building. A chicken house away from the one previously mentioned housed separate of poor standards where the whole enclosure was covered with a brown cloth although it was roofed. It was housing a few chickens (elevated) that were already out to the local markets being sold. We found 6 broiler chickens in one narrow steel cage. The chicken house was not clean and water was in tippable bowls. The Rock Pigeons were secured in a built-up cage with a pitched roof and they kept in the same structure as the road-runners. One of the bitches gave birth to 7 puppies in the chicken house. She also had dogs(6) on the property she didn't provide adequate shelter for. Only a med-large wooden dog kennel with a capacity of up to 2 dogs, the rest of the dogs used hideouts that they could find in the rubble and under an old wrecked trailer. We asked her to take the goats to the vet and she agreed to do so tomorrow at her vet in Vereeniging . We managed to get her to sign over the nursing bitch with puppies and 2 other dogs. I still issued her a written warning to get veterinary or medical treatment for the goats and to improve her facilities to better standards within 30 days unless specified otherwise.
