General Report Comments: The stable yard is an upcoming riding establishment of approximately 13 sheep, 15 horses, 14 stables and about 58 chickens (15 are battery hens). Different groups of animals are owned by different owners on this rented property. All the animals belong to at least 4 people at this property. The horses and 9 sheep belong to Mr Adam Lahree, 4 sheep and battery hens to Mr Abdullah and the rest of the (free range) chicken belonged to Mr Jeremiah Chuma. Two of the horses in appeared to be losing weight, the adult grey stallion named "Fidel" and an adult, dark bay, (nursing) mare named "Destiny". The stallion was believed to be chasing one of the mares that was on heat and that affected his feeding routine but "Destiny" on the other hand, just birth to a newborn foal, hence, the decline in weight. The stables (some) were not in good repair - broken doors and broken wall panels. A thick belt of manure was found in at least 3 stables. The sheep had shelter (substandard) that was less than a meter high even though it was still able to accommodate all heads of animals. The shelter was built inside a pen/enclosure with adequate running space. Mr Lahree said he is keeping the sheep for consumption and to strategically minimize the infestation of worms affecting the horses (a notion he recently leant). The chicken run was dirty, untidy and unhygienic with a large vehicle canopy placed there for covering up. There doesn't appear to be an active cleaning routine for the chickens. The layers kept in one of the stables in a battery system made droppings of faeces causing a fly-infestation in and around the stables. No fly-repelling measure put in place. Written warnings were issued to all owners of the animals at this property.
