General Report Comments: I met the complainant's spouse at the Bryanston Veterinary Hospital who was taking their dog for "Oreo" a black, tan & white, 6-month-old, female Bull terrier for an check up. While waiting she was in the waiting, she explained to me that the vet suspects some form of a chemical burn when they noticed the wounded front paw pads on the 11th January 2026 fetching and immediately took the dog to the vet. The vet had a brief exam of the dog and booked the dog for a follow-up check today. When "Oreo" came out she had a bandage wrapped on the left front leg. Dr van der Westhuizen stated to me that he is not sure what may have been the cause of the wounds. I requested a report on the dog's exam to be forwarded to me while I proceed with my investigations at The Puppy Palace
