"Bella" is reportedly wounded from a cat fight with a neighbour's cat. The cat was then taken to the Randburg Veterinary Hospital, where they prescribed topical medication for her. The medication was reportedly causing some irritation for the cat, and she kept scratching, keeping the wound raw. They tried putting the buster collar to prevent this but the cat kept taking it off, according to the owner. They moved on to the spray application and they claimed to be seeing some improvements. Medication and vets visits were presented to me.
