General Report Comments: UPON OUR ARRIVAL, WE WERE INFORMED TO WAIT FOR MR ROGERS WHO SHOWED US AROUND. WE NOTICED APPROXIMATELY 25 DOGS ON THE PROPERTY, FIVE OF WHICH WERE VERY UNDERWEIGHT WITH THEIR RIBS AND HIP BONES SHOWING. ONE OF THESE DOGS ALSO HAD WEEPY EYES. THE DOGS ALSO SEEMED QUITE FERAL AND UN-SOCIALISED. I INFORMED MR ROGERS THAT THE DOGS ALL NEEDED TO BE DEWORMED AND THEIR FOOD INTAKE INCREASED, AS THEIR CONDITION WAS UNACCEPTABLE. A FOLLOW-UP INSPECTION ON THESE DOGS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN TWO WEEKS TO SEE IF THERE IS ANY IMPROVEMENT. THE CATS SEEMED ACCEPTABLE EXCEPT FOR TWO WHO WERE THIN, HAD CRUSTY EARS, AND WERE CLEARLY ILL. I WAS INFORMED BY MR ROGERS THAT THESE TWO CATS, FELIX AND BOBBY HAD CANCER AND WERE GOING TO BE EUTHANIZED. .
