She granted me access to the grooming palour and claimed she knows who complained. She further showed me proof that she paid for the medical bill of the dog in question.

Ann then stated she was in hospital and she was shocked when she received the pictures. According to Ann the dog was very mattered and she thinks the blade became blunt in the process of shaving the dog as it had a mattered coat.

I checked the machine that they are using and tested it on my skin. It appears to be sharp and i questioned how after how many months do they get their blade sharpened. Her reply was after every 3 months. The cages appears to be clean and i checked 2 dogs that were recently groomed. The dogs didn't have any cuts and they appear to be in good health. According to Ann they apply Pottash if they see a small cut on an animal and the blades are disinfected by F10.

Ann has 4 cats that i observed and the cats have access to the cattery that is build outside the house through the window. These cats have access to the house at all times. The cats have access to portable water and the living environment is clean.

Education:

-I informed Ann that the blades must be sharped every month to ensure the same incident doesn't happen again.

-If a trainee is grooming the dog, the trainee must work under supervision at all times to avoid any injuries or pain that can be caused in the process of grooming

-if the animal is faisty/has attitude and it difficult to handle. The owner must hold the animal and if the owner refused , the animal mustn't be groomed to unnecessary pain that can be caused to the animal.

Case can be closed as this is a civil matter since the dog in question was taken to the veterinarian and the owner of the palour paid for the bill.
