I questioned Anaiya regarding the rope that is on the veranda and according to Anaiya the dog was in for a surgery at the veterinarian . The dog is suppose to be on cage rest as it is hyper active. The only reason the dog was tethered with a rope is because she realized the is a bit hyper. I requested to see the medication that was prescribed by the veterinarian.

Anaiya came back with the medication which was a proof that the dog in question is still recovering from the surgery. The reason for the dog to be tethered was valid as the rope is adequate length.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962. There is no further action that can be taken in terms of the law. Case can be closed until further notice.
