I requested the complaint to send me a picture of the house that must be investigated and she did , which made it easy for me to find the house.

Upon arrival i met Clinton and his family. I shared a nature of complaint and they granted me access to the property. There is no gate at the property and one dog named named Foxy is on a stating chain in the entrance. Foxy was observed is a good condition and the chain length was approximately 2.5 meters. Foxy has access to adequate kennel and water is provided. The living environment was observed clean and hygienic. I observed that there is no collar provided for Foxy however Clinton stated that Foxy break collars.

Clinton that took me to the back yard where i observed 2 dogs named Roxy and Rockie. Both dogs appears to be slightly underweight and they are clinically alart. According to Clinton he had the dogs for two months and they were underweight when he got them from Chartsworth. Looking at the body score of the dogs i questioned when were the dogs dewormed and according to him the dogs never received a dewormer. I advised the dogs must be dewormed and be fed 3 times a day. The dogs at the back yard and he understood. I requested to see dog food and he went to the house. Clinton came back with a bucket full of pellets which is adequate food.

I then told Clinton i wanna see the 4th dog. He tried to deny and i told him it a criminal offense to conceal animal/s from an inspector. He then told me to follow him and we went up the stairs. At the corner of the property i observed a dog named Danger on a static chain that is 6 meters and the dog has access to adequate shelter. Water is provided and Danger appears to be in a good condition . However there was no collar observed and no injuries were seen on the dog. The chain where Danger is kept is 6 meters.

I issued a warning

Untie/unchain animal/s immediately to roam freely inside the property or provide a running chain within 7 days.

Remarks:

-Provider a running chain for Foxy within 7 days so Foxy can express animal natural behavior.

- provide adequate collar for Foxy and Danger within 7 days to prevent injuries.
