General Report Comments: Upon arrival I met Mr Hadebe

He is the worker on site and they are busy changing the fencing at this property that I'm investigating.

I shared a nature of complaint and he explained to me that the dogs found a hole at night. They exited the property and they were able to confine the dogs. They built a temporary enclosure to ensure that the dogs don't go out at all while they are changing the entire fencing. On my observation there were 3 african guys busy putting up the new fencing.

Mr Hadebe took me to where the dogs are kept. The enclosure is adequate size and the dogs can express animal natural behavior. The dogs appear to be in a good condition having access to shelter. Portable water is provided and living environment is clean.

The owner is not home during the time of an inspection however Mr Hadebe gave me the contact details of the owner.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
