I went to the back where i observed 2 dogs that appeared to be in a good condition. Portable water is provided and the living environment is clean.

I entered the main house and on the left hand side one dog is kept in a big room. The dog coat is growing back and the living environment is clean. Portable water is provided and the living environment is clean.

I walked through the passage first right door. 2 dogs were observed in a good condition and clinically alart. The living environment is clean and hygienic. The dogs have access to portable water and there is light, ventilation.

On the left hand side on the other room 2 dogs were observed in a good condition. The living environment is clean and hygienic. Portable water is provided for the dogs.

I further walked to the back where is observed 3 dogs. The dogs appeared to be in a good condition and clinically alart. The dogs are kept in a clean living environment.

Overall there is no harmonic smell or buildup of feaces. The living area is well mantained and i advised Samantha to surrender dogs to the SPCA but she's refusing as she has support from Sue Chambell.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
