She then showed me the house that has dogs that attacked her. I then met Mr Naicker who explained to me that he is aware the dogs attacked Thandeka however she did make an arrangement to take her to kwaDabeka Clinic but Thandeka wanted to be taken to Hillcrest Private hospital. Due to finances he could take her to private hospital. Mr naicker also stated that Thandeka has been swearing at him and he decided not to communicate. Mrs Naicker was present and she explained how Thandeka got attacked by the dog . According to Mrs Naicker they were coming back from Church and Her dog came running happy to see Mrs Naicker. That when Thandeka started to scream and ranaway. The dog then discharged to attack her and she pulled the dog away.

Mrs Naicker isn't interested to surrender her dogs. The dogs were observed in a good condition and clinically alert. The dogs has access to shelter and the property isn't adequately fenced, as there is no fencing in the front.

I issued a warning

-To keep your animal/s inside your premises at all times.

Ensure the dogs are monitored at all times and if you cannot control the dogs. Sign them over to SPCA.
