General Report Comments: Upon arrival both dogs were running around freely in the front yard. Mr Awad explained the dogs got into a fight with one another and he tied the Pitbull for a short period to calm the dogs down. No evidence of permanent or long term chaining/tethering was visible on the dogs. Both dogs are in satisfactory condition. The front and back yards are separated but the dogs have access to free roam the entire yard. The shelter for the dogs is underneath the front stoep area, as well as, their food and water.

I suggested that the dogs be sterilised to reduce hormones playing a role in aggression. I informed Mr Awad that in future he cannot tie or chain the dogs, he should rather just separate them in the front and back yards. Additionally, I advised that if the fighting continues that Mr Awad considers surrendering one of the dogs to SPCA.
