General Report Comments: Arrival: 06:00

Cattle (30 animals):

Gridding in the cattle holding area was loose and bent; noted that replacements with better alternatives are planned.

Stun-to-cut time within 40 seconds.

Bleed-out time was under 8 minutes; issue addressed and rectified.

Vocalization observed in one cow.

Sheep (130 animals):

Stunning performed on the eye.

Stun-to-cut time within 40 seconds.

Observed that fewer sheep in the stunning area increase stress; 4–5 sheep in the holding area seems to keep them calmer.

One partially stunned sheep escaped; instead of re-stunning, slaughter proceeded with another sheep.

Return guide for hooks appears damaged, causing sheep to fall directly to the floor, generating excessive noise and stress.

Discussion:

Held with Johan regarding sheep holding area for stunning. Recommendation made appears feasible; Johan also demonstrated plans for a conveyor belt system to improve handling.

Pigs:

Slaughter process runs smoothly.

Stunning time, position, and handling are satisfactory.

Cut and bleed-out correct.

Pigs waiting for slaughter were standing in the sun and panting.

One downer pig observed; after hosing and providing water, she was able to stand and move into shade.
