General Report Comments: General Biosecurity

Biosecurity measures were present at all entrances and appeared to be functional at the time of inspection.

Cattle Observations

A cow with two calves was noted to have very little water, which was dirty, although feed was available.

One cow was found entangled in bale string but managed to free herself without assistance.

Cattle in the lairages were observed without access to water or feed at the time of inspection.

Three cattle were noted with injuries to their tails. This was immediately raised with the AHT, who treated the affected animals with wound spray.

One cow was noted to have an injury above the hoof, which was also attended to by the AHT using wound spray.

Cattle were observed slipping in the lairages, attributed to wet flooring and bulls displaying heightened aggression, resulting in pushing and shoving behaviour.

No fly control measures were observed on the premises.

Animals were being placed into dirty lairages despite clean enclosures being available, which was raised with management during the inspection.

A broom head and cloth were found inside one of the water troughs; these were immediately removed by the inspector to prevent contamination.

Wildlife Observation

One indigenous guinea fowl was found on the premises.

The sale yard management was informed that keeping or trading in indigenous wildlife is not permitted.

The fowl was signed over to the Springs SPCA and subsequently transferred to the Johannesburg Wildlife Veterinary Hospital for care and appropriate placement.
