General Report Comments: Livestock Observed:

31 Cattle – Some animals noted with scarring from previous branding. Minor tail injuries observed again.

50 Goats

69 Sheep

3 Ducks

10 Rabbits

95 Chickens

Observations & Actions:

The owner has issued a warning to the worker responsible for inappropriate cattle handling, including tail twisting, hitting in the face, and kicking.

Water containers have been ordered for the sheep and goat enclosures to ensure constant access to fresh water.

Cattle are moved to lairages that have access to water immediately following auction activities.

Additional fly traps have been ordered and are expected to arrive next week to assist with fly control and overall hygiene.

The cattle lairages were paved approximately seven years ago, as per SPCA instruction. Due to water runoff and the fact that the property is leased and not owned by the operator, no further structural modifications can currently be made.

Management has committed to ensuring that more active or aggressive cattle are separated to prevent fighting and minimize the risk of slipping or injury.

Conclusion:

Overall animal conditions are acceptable, with some minor welfare concerns noted regarding previous injuries and handling practices. Management has taken corrective action, and continued monitoring is recommended to ensure that handling standards and water provision remain compliant with SPCA requirements.
