General Report Comments: The property has a dam that has flooded due to the recent heavy rainfall. As a result, the entire property and pig pens are flooded. The pig pens cannot be swept clean as the water has nowhere to go. The owner of the property is in the process of pumping out the dam to reduce the water levels. Two areas of the pig pens are occupied with pigs, with the top area not as bad as the bottom area. The top area has concrete floors and does not have a deep layer of mud; however, the bottom area does not have concrete flooring; therefore, the entire floor is ankle deep with mud and water. In the top area, a section can be cordoned off to put the bottom area's piglets into, however, the fencing would need to be covered in order for the pigs not to have nose to nose contact. Mr Lottering suggested he put feed bags against the fencing.

By the house's little garden, the grass is extremely long; however, the grass cannot be cut with a lawnmower due to the wetness. I suggested to Mr Lottering at cutting the grass with a weedeater. Inside the house, the two dogs inside are slightly thin. The food being fed is Montego Classic; however, I suspect the dogs have not been on the brand of food for long. In the cupboard in the kitchen the tick and flea products used on the dogs are present, and inside the fridge are all the medicines used to inject the pigs when required.
