Comments:	Cheslyn Prins arrived at the SPCA to vlain Spartan. He apologized for his wifes behaviour. He explained that they built a running chain for Spartan. I made a release contratct for him to sign to sterilize and microchip gis animal and that if they contravene the Animals Protection Act again that the dog will be confiscated. I told him the dog needs to be microchipped and that it costs R175 for this. He explained that he gets paid the 25th and is the only one working in the household and his one daughter is working. I wanted to book Spartan for sterilization on the 6th of November 2024 but he said he gets a bonus in December and will be able to accept the first date in January 2025. I explained he can pay before then. I also eplained the Animals Protection Act and the Drakenstein bylaws to him so that he can understand what they need to abide by. He said he will be able to pay the microchip next week and let us know when he has the cash. He wanted to take the dog home today but nobody is home. I explained that I first need to do an inspection at his home before returning Spartan to them. He was upset with this but understood it eventually. We microchipped Spartan. The home check needs to be done tomorrow and of they compliex, Spartan can be returned. Spartan will be sterilized the 8th of January 2025.
