General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at the facility for a follow up on the repairs that was asked to be done regarding the ramps and non slip flooring.

 We met with Bok and explained this to him. He asked Aidan to assist us on the ground.

 We went to the area where the sheep are offloaded and kept. All the transport ramps had gridding fixed to the ground to prevent sheep from slipping and injuring themselves. I also educated Aidan to keep an eye on the grids in the long run as it might lift in future. He took note of this.

 A truck offloaded a sheep with an anal prolaps, to which we asked them to immediately that that sheep to the emergency slaughter area. They complied immediately. I told him to train his guys to always keep an eye out for this as it becomes their responsibility as soon as they accept the load.

 We then went to the Cattle ramp, slaughter run and camps and all had brand new gridding to prevent the cattle from slipping. I did not observe one cattle to slip and fall today. The metal panels on the sides of the slaughter run had sharp edges protruding that can cause additional injury whilst the cattle are waiting for slaughter. I told Thomas the manager here about the issue. They also added a conveyer belt inside the crush to provide non slip flooring. They are going to trial and error different rubber mats etc.

 Their one captive bokt has broken but the additional one is still brand new. The hydraulic press is also being used.

 They complied with everything but I issued a warning as seen attached.
