General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani, arrived at the property. After hooting a few times, the owner Adam came out to greet us. He informed us that he never got any of the letters we left at his property.

The dogs had one kennel under an enclosed shed. The kennels planks were broken and is only enough for one dog. There was a bucket of water for them and they were free roaming in the yard.

We did see a chain attached to the kennel. When asked, Adam said he sometimes chain them at night as other dogs enter the property and they fight. I suggested he keeps them freroamingbor place them on running chains. However each time we visited the dogs were safely free roaming inside the property.

He did not have food for his dogs at the time and said he feeds them three times a day and give pap. I explained pap has no nutritional value, bones can get stuck and potato peeps make the dogs thin. I explained why dog pellets are essential.

He brought his animals vaccination records and we saw that they haven't been dewormed in quite a long time. We decided to give the dogs dewormer as Adam is unemployed and has no money.

We issued a warning to Adam to:

- 1) Provide your dogs with adequate food (preferably puppy food) twice a day within 6 days. - do not give bones, pap and potato peeps to eat.
- 2) Ensure to provide both dogs with adequate shelter (pallets as flooring within 6 days)

We also gave him extra Frontline that we had.
